Sajan is first-ever Indian swimmer to make Olympic cut

New Delhi, June 27: Sajan Prakash on Saturday became the firstever Indian swimmer to qualify for the Olympic Games by breaching the 'A' standard time, clocking 1:56:38 seconds in the men's 200m butterfly event at the Sette Colli Trophy in Rome, Italy.

The Games 'A' standard was set at 1:56.48 seconds and the 27-year-old Prakash completed the run 0.10 seconds faster at the FINA-accredited Olympic qualifier.

Modi govt harassing farmers since **2014: Cong**

New Delhi, June 27: The Modi government harassing been farmers not just for the last seven months of their protest against the three farm laws, but since it came to power seven years ago, the Congress alleged on Saturday.

chief Party Randeep spokesperson Surjewala also posed a set of seven questions to the central government, asking whether it was working on a policy to "tire and drive away, harass and defeat. defame and divide" the protesting farmers by conspiring against them.

The protest against the laws by farmers camping at various Delhi border points began in November last year and they are demanding that the legislations be withdrawn

"Even though farmers are sitting on an agitation since November last year, Modi government been conspiring to harass them for the last seven years ever since it came to power in 2014 by bringing the Land Acquisition Act to take away their land," Surjewala said.

The Government and farmer unions have held 11 rounds of talks so far. the last being on January 22, to break the deadlock and end the protest. Talks have not resumed following widespread violence during a tractor by protesting farmers on January 26.
